

TITCHFIELD NEIGHBOURHOOD FORUM NEWSLETTER 25.06.17

APPLICATION TO BUILD 150 HOMES IN POSBROOKE LANE - many of you will know that Foreman Homes have put in a planning application to build 150 homes plus a scout hut on the field between Bellfield and Posbrooke Lane.

At the Forum meeting on 20th June, the Forum voted overwhelmingly to object to this development. I will, therefore, be writing to Fareham Borough Council to oppose the idea.

In addition, anyone who is against this development should also write to FBC with their objections. You can view the application by visiting the Fareham Borough Council website at www.fareham.gov.uk/planningonline choosing the "Application Search" Link and using the reference number P/17/0681/OA. You may also view the application by visiting the Civic Offices between 8.45am and 5.15pm Monday to Friday.

If you wish to object, the address to write to is: Fareham Borough Council, Department of Planning & Regulation, Civic Offices, Civic Way, Fareham, PO16 7AZ or you can e mail them on rwright@fareham.gov.uk

The reference you should include is: **Planning Application P/17/0681/OA**. The Council must receive your application by **7th July 2017**.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT -Whilst opposing the large Posbrooke development, the Forum also voted unanimously for some development in the next 20 years on small (preferably brown field) sites around the village. This will hopefully increase the range of houses for young people to buy or rent.
