

## TITCHFIELD NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The starting point of developing a Neighbourhood Plan was to define the area that would be covered by the Plan. This took some time but was finally agreed after discussions with FBC - **Map item 1**.

Then the views of residents were canvassed. Over 500 questionnaires were sent to residents, businesses and local groups. 152 questionnaires were returned. These were analysed and the results published and presented at a meeting of the Forum in February 2016

The results of the survey have been key factors in the development of the Neighbourhood Plan. Since January 2016 there has been much activity. Sub-groups of the Forum have worked on specific topics. Prior to the consultation period, there have been 5 public meetings and there have been obvious changes within the village and surrounds. The **Consultation Document, item 2** shows the way in which the residents have been consulted.

**The Conditions Statement, Item 3** shows how the Forum has met the legal requirements for a Neighbourhood Plan.

**Item 4 is the poster** being used throughout the village shows:

- when and how the Plan may be inspected
- how comments may be made

A flyer delivered to every house in the Neighbourhood Plan area contains similar information. There will also be newspaper articles, Parish Magazine articles and, hopefully, tv interview providing this information.

**Item 5 is a summary** of the main proposals of the Neighbourhood Plan

The Forum has been able to draw on much valuable historic data and on contributions made by individuals and the many societies in the village.
